


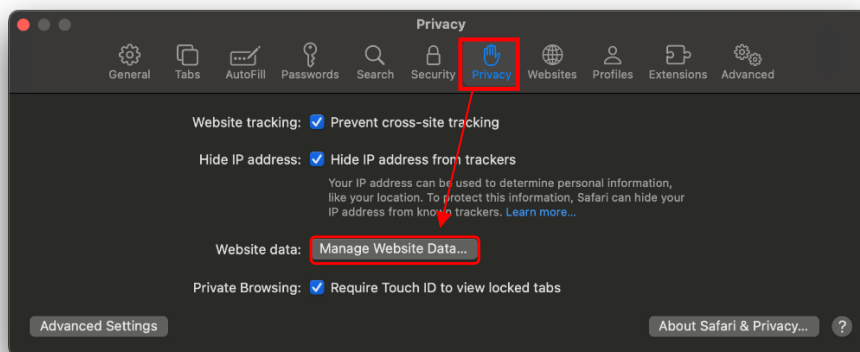

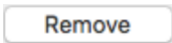

Clear cookies in Safari on Mac

You can see all the websites that have stored [cookies and website data](#) on your Mac, and you can remove some or all of it.

For macOS Monterey, Ventura, and Sonoma:

1. In the Safari app  on your Mac, click **Safari** in the top left corner.
2. Select **Preferences (macOS Monterey)** or **Settings (macOS Ventura and Sonoma)** from the menu.
3. On the next window, click **Privacy** in the top navigation bar.
4. Click **Manage Website Data...**



5. On the next window, you can remove cookies for individual sites or for all sites listed.
 - **Remove Individual Sites** = click to highlight one or more websites, then click .
 - **Remove All Sites** = click .
6. Next, click **Remove Now** to finish.
7. It is recommended to close the browser completely for the changes to take effect. Click Safari in the top left corner > select Quit Safari from the menu. After the browser closes completely, click to open it again and continue working.
